SCOUT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

It is the Policy of the NSW Contingent that for a Scout to attend the 22nd Australian Jamboree all of the following eligibility requirements must be met;

Must be a registered Scout

Must have attained the Pioneer Badge prior to 30th September, 2009

Must have had achieved at least 10 nights under canvas as a Scout, with at least one camp of three (3) consecutive nights included

Must not have attained the age of 15 years, as at 4th January, 2010 Scouts who have achieved their 15th birthday on or prior to this date will not be eligible to participate

Must display appropriate behaviour at all times.

Where a Scout has been a member of the Scout Section for 12 months or less, an assessment relating to Scouting skills and ability to cope with such a lengthy camp will be conducted by the Region Liaison Leader (RLL), who will submit a recommendation prior to the applicant being approved or rejected as a member of the NSW Contingent.

Membership of the Scout Section commences from the date the NSW State Membership Record identifies the youth member as entering the Scout Section.

These requirements are set by the National Organisation, as well as, the NSW State Scout Mindari and are designed to assist Scouts to achieve the highest quality experience possible from the Jamboree.
